CCSB Administration Committee Meeting – Elizabeth Hutchins

The Board discussed the organizational chart, revised salary scale, retirement of several employees, and the need for additional clerical staff. School Health Advisory Board (SHAB) Meeting – Michelle North

The SHAB Committee met on May 14, 2014 at 6 p.m. at the School Board Office. Dr. Houck reviewed legislation that has been passed by the Virginia General Assembly and signed by the Governor related to health. They also discussed a bill that failed which would have required physical activity in grades K-5 consisting of at least 20 minutes per day or an average of 100 minutes per week during the regular school year and available to all students grades 6-12. Dr. Davis and Ms. Downes presented reports from the Virginia Department of Health on various communicable diseases in Culpeper. Dr. Davis also led a discussion on immunization requirements and changes in the law as of July 1. Greg Beamer gave an overview of the school food service program and the new regulations that will take place July 1st. Adam Gresham presented information on the high school health and physical education program. The next meeting will be in the fall 2014.
