<u>Title:</u> Our Money	
<u>Before Reading:</u> -Predict and Preview Selection -Ask for and/or provide background knowledge -Vocabulary instruction/preview (if needed for unknown words)	
<u>During Reading:</u> <u>Word Work</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- long e- beginning blends Vocabulary <ul style="list-style-type: none">- spend, save, cash, check, credit card, money, \$, cent sign, penny, nickel, dime, quarter, dollar, goods, services -Listen to Individual Reader	
<u>Guiding Questions</u> Page 2- Why do we need money? Page 3- What are the three things you can use to buy stuff? Pages 4-15: After each purchase determine if a good or service was paid for. Page 16- What can you do with money besides spend it? Why is this important?
